in Croatia

Join a small group, led by the experienced Austrian bird guide Dr. Herbert Bödendorfer.

The greater Zadar area offers a wide range of photo opportunities on the coast and in the hinterland, which we have explored in recent years. The focus is on Lake Vransko.

Two full-day excursions lead to the area around Nin and to the island of Pag.

We have good chances of observing and photographing Pygmy Cormorants, Golden Orioles, Hoopoes, Rollers, Turtle Doves, Zitting Cisticola, Reed Warblers, Cetti's Warblers, Herons, Gossy Ibises, Nightingales, Bee-eaters, Wheatears, Harriers, Subalpine and Sardinian warblers, Cirl Buntings, Black-headed buntings, Woodchat and Lesser Grey Shrikes, Whinchats, Blue Rock Thrushes, Nightjars, Scops Owls, Eagle Owls, ... to name just a few specialities.
